
- What: What does imitate Christ look like

3 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.


4 He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not **in** him.

1 John 4:17

1 John 2:5-6

5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the **love of God is perfected** in him. By this we know that we are in Him. 6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to **walk just as He walked**.

- Holy Spirit raised Him in the flesh
- Defeated Death
- Born Again, First of many
- With Father, Interceding
- Fulfilled Scripture Prophesy
- Released Holy Spirit so we can follow

Humble and Obedient to the point of death

Philippians 2:5-8

5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.

8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Be Like Minded, Have The Same Love

Philippians 2:1-5

2 Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by **being like-minded**, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, **but in lowliness of mind** (Humility) **let each esteem others better than himself**. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

Love IS: 1 Cor 13:4-7

- NKJV: 4 Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 5 does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; 6 does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; 7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
- NIV: 4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
- AMP: 4 Love endures with patience and serenity, love is kind and thoughtful, and is not jealous or envious; love does not brag and is not proud or arrogant. 5 It is not rude; it is not self-seeking, it is not provoked [nor overly sensitive and easily angered]; it does not take into account a wrong endured. 6 It does not rejoice at injustice, but rejoices with the truth [when right and truth prevail]. 7 Love bears all things [regardless of what comes], believes all things [looking for the best in each one], hopes all things [remaining steadfast during difficult times], endures all things [without weakening].

Put Carnality to Death, Put on Love

Colossians 3

3 If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. 3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

5 Therefore **put to death your members** which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, 7 in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.

8 But now you yourselves are to **put off all these**: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you have **put off the old man** with his deeds, 10 and have **put on the new man** who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, 11 where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all.

12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, **put on** tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But above all these things **put on love**, which is the bond of perfection. 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Transformation / Baptism

Put Off the old man and His deeds

- Put to death earthly "members"
- Bury Corrupted Body with Jesus Be raised in Christ to new life
- Past Dead and Hidden in Christ
- Born Again Child of God Put On the new man
- Holy and Blessed, Elect of God
- Renewed in knowledge
- Image Restored
- Christ in and Through You

New Man: Spiritual, Love

Set your mind on things above

- Love and pursue God and His kingdom
- Word of God dwells richly in wisdom
- Teach and admonish others
- Sing with grace in your heart to the Lord
- Peace of God rules in your heart, One Body
- Do all in the name of the Lord, Thanks to God
- Glory When Christ appears in you and thru you

How: Next Steps

- What can we do going forward?
 - Pause / Reflect: Do I Love God or Love Myself more?
 - Time, Thoughts, Actions, Resources
 - Ask: Where is "Self" still keeping Jesus (Love) from forming in me?
 - Pride? Ego? Fear? Faith?
 - Ask God for insight on your journey
 - Where is MY will still not aligned with YOUR will
- How do we know it is working?
 - You seek His face and let Him lead you through opportunities
 - You start to care and notice more opportunities
 - You recognize more internal barriers to address
- What do we do when we notice a barrier?
 - Run to God
 - Thank Him for helping your notice, Caring is the first step
 - Seek to understand the driver (usually your self-centered will)
 - Repent
 - Claim calling to be better: We are clay, He is the potter, He will finish His work

Discussion

- Does this make sense?
 - Questions
 - Clarification
 - Other Inputs
- Practical Experiences in this Area
 - Successes
 - Struggles / Barriers
 - Strategies to Overcome
 - Lesson Learned

Discussion:

- Folks struggle when they still see flaws in themselves after striving to do well. Are they really doing ok? Are they on the right track. Huge lesson is that caring is the first step. Before you cared you were oblivious to the issue and didn't recognize the flaw or its consequences. Now you notice and care, and that is a big deal. Now run to God with it and let Him help change you.
- We are each on a journey with unique situations and unique internal barriers.
- It is wonderful when you can be connected to God, Listen to input, respond, and see results.
- We have opportunities to leverage our new born again identity and fight back against the fallen world. I have some teaching to help. Several on the call have testimonies to share at some point

Success:

- Heard God suggest creating a Church info card to hand out
- Created Church Card with Church, Paster, Service times, Address, Prayer Numbers, Her Name
- Offer to folks who are receptive
- Several recent folks acknowledged need to find a church
- Felt Joy in spirit for listening, doing, and then seeing result




