Steal, Kill, and Destroy	To ruin lives, destinies, families, and anything God loves.	John 10:10 – “The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy.”
Blind People to the Truth	To stop unbelievers from seeing Jesus and receiving salvation.	2 Corinthians 4:4 – “The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, lest the light of the gospel... should shine on them.”
Steal the Word of God	To prevent spiritual growth, faith, and transformation.	Mark 4:15 – “Satan comes immediately and takes away the word that was sown in their hearts.”
Deceive With Lies	To distort identity, truth, doctrine, and God's character.	John 8:44 – “He is a liar and the father of it.”
Accuse and Condemn	To destroy confidence, identity, and intimacy with God.	Revelation 12:10 – “The accuser of our brethren... accuses them before our God day and night.”
Tempt Into Sin	To lure people into bondage and spiritual slavery.	James 1:14–15 – “Each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires... and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.”
Divide and Cause Strife	To weaken marriages, churches, families, and communities.	Mark 3:25 – “A house divided against itself will not stand.”
Oppress and Wear Down	To exhaust believers until they give up or turn away.	Daniel 7:25 – “He shall wear out the saints of the Most High.”
Counterfeit the Things of God	To deceive through spiritual-looking lies and false religion.	2 Corinthians 11:14 – “For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.”
Inspire Rebellion and Disobedience	To break alignment with God and empower darkness.	Ephesians 2:2 – “The spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience.”
Devour the Vulnerable	To destroy those who are isolated, wounded, or unguarded.	1 Peter 5:8 – “Your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.”
