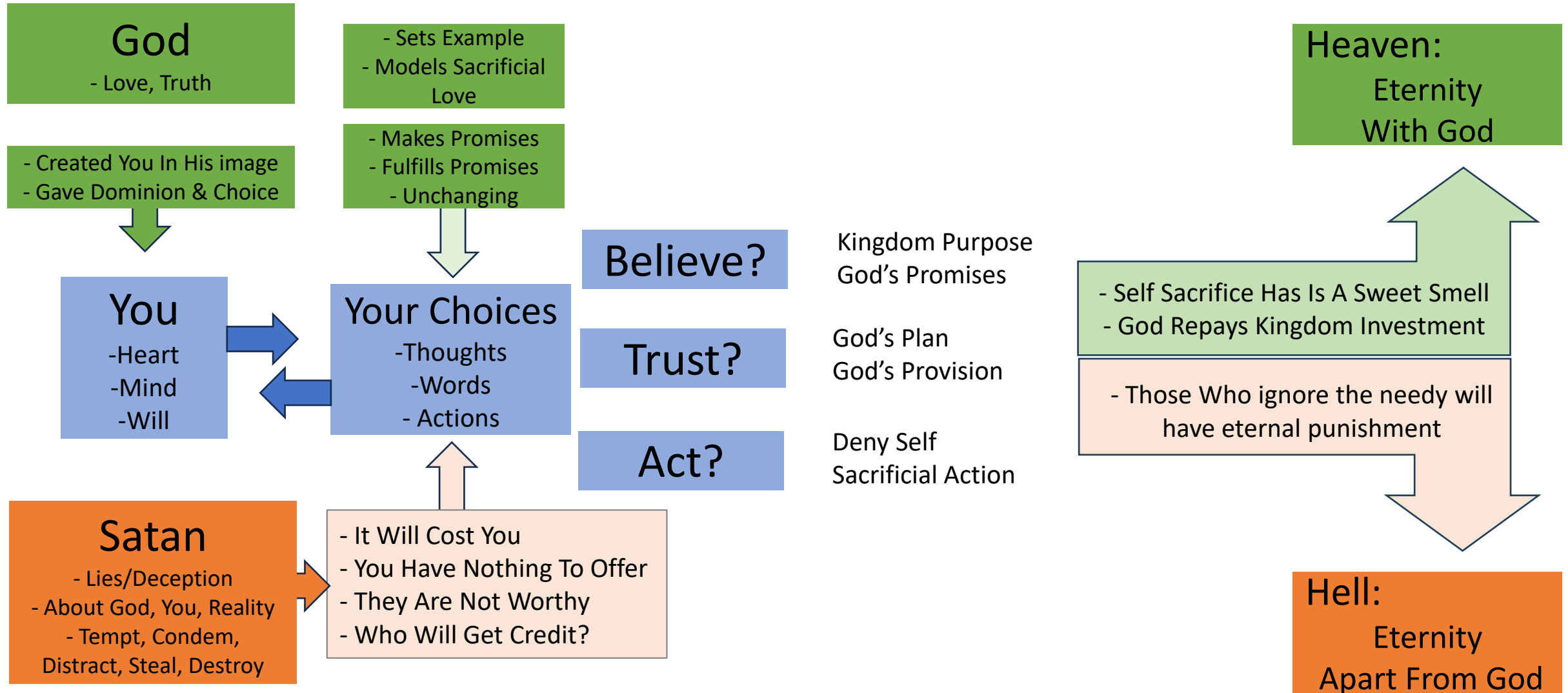

Sacrifice	Give up comfort, security, possessions, or relationships to follow Christ	Matthew 19:29 — Whoever leaves these things for Christ’s sake “shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life.”
	Present your whole life to God	Romans 12:1 — “Present your bodies a living sacrifice, ... your reasonable service.”
Flesh	Crucify sinful passions and desires	Galatians 5:24 — “Those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.”

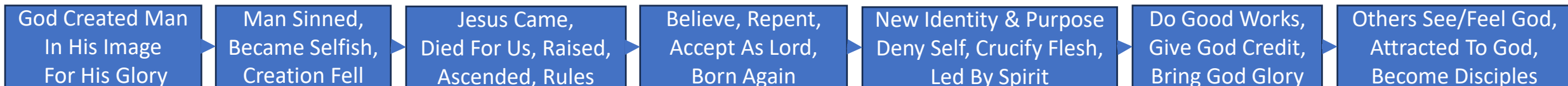

Sacrificial Action Helps Liberate Us From Self

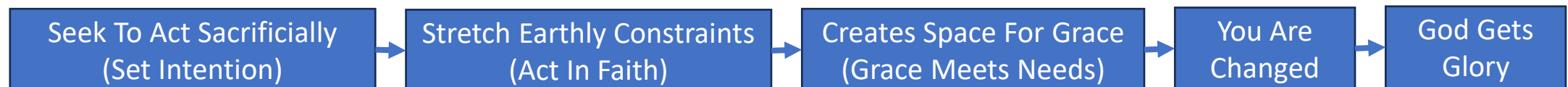
Isaiah 58:6-10

“Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke?”

Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover him, and not to hide yourself from your own flesh?

Then shall your light break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard.

Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer; you shall cry, and he will say, ‘Here I am.’ If you take away the yoke from your midst, the pointing of the finger, and speaking wickedness, If you pour yourself out for the hungry and satisfy the desire of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday.”



Sacrificial Service Transforms The Investor

Progression	What It Produces in Us	Key Verse
1. Jesus sets the example of sacrificial love	Jesus shows us what God's love looks like in action and gives us a model to follow.	Ephesians 5:2 — "Walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God."
2. We surrender and make ourselves available	We respond to His love by placing our entire lives under His lordship and at His disposal.	Romans 12:1 — "Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God."
3. A new heart gives us compassion	God replaces our hardened, self-centered heart and gives us a desire to love and serve others.	Ezekiel 36:26 — "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you."
4. The Father's love fills and motivates us	Receiving His love gives us both the security and the love we need to release to others.	1 John 4:19 — "We love Him because He first loved us."
5. God's Word reveals His character to imitate	Scripture renews our thinking and teaches us how God loves, forgives, gives, and serves.	Ephesians 5:1 — "Be imitators of God as dear children."
6. The Holy Spirit gives us direction and power	He reveals where and how to invest and empowers us to overcome resistance of the flesh.	Galatians 5:16 — "Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."
7. Sacrifice denies the flesh	We choose God's purposes over comfort, pride, fear, appetite, and self-interest.	Luke 9:23 — "Deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me."
8. Repeated obedience strengthens our resolve	Faithful choices develop our readiness and determination to obey when sacrifice is required.	1 Corinthians 9:27 — "I discipline my body and bring it into subjection."
9. Perseverance produces maturity	Continuing through discomfort, resistance, and delayed results makes us stable and complete.	James 1:3-4 — "The testing of your faith produces patience...that you may be perfect and complete."
10. Maturity produces kingdom fruit	God's love flows through our transformed lives to serve others and bring Him glory.	John 15:8 — "By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit."

God Promises To Repay / Reward Investments

God Repays/Rewards Investment	Key Verse
We reap what we sow	Galatians 6:7–9 — “Whatever a man sows, that he will also reap...in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.”
He multiplies what we release	2 Corinthians 9:6, 10–11 — Those who sow bountifully reap bountifully; God will “multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness.”
He returns using your measure	Luke 6:38 — “Give, and it will be given to you...For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”
He supplies our needs	Philippians 4:17–19 — After recognizing the fruit credited to their account, Paul promises, “My God shall supply all your need.”
He credits spiritual fruit to our account	Philippians 4:15–17 — “I seek the fruit that abounds to your account.”
He entrusts faithful stewards with more	Matthew 25:21 — “You were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things...”
He returns mercy and forgiveness	Luke 6:36–37; Matthew 5:7 — “Forgive, and you will be forgiven”; “the merciful...shall obtain mercy.”
He repays sacrifices made for Jesus	Mark 10:29–30 — Those who sacrifice for Jesus and the gospel receive “a hundredfold now in this time”—with persecutions—“and in the age to come, eternal life.”
He repays generosity to the poor / repays what others can not repay	Proverbs 19:17 — Whoever gives to the poor “lends to the LORD, He will pay back what he has given.”
	Luke 14:13–14 — Serve those unable to return the favor, “for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just.”
He stores up eternal treasure / Gives Eternal rewards	Matthew 6:19–20 — “Lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven.”
	Matthew 5:12; Revelation 22:12 — “Great is your reward in heaven”; Jesus says, “My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.”

God knows everything - the end from the beginning	Nothing surprises Him; He understands every condition affecting His promises.	Isaiah 46:9–10 — “Declaring the end from the beginning...My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure.”
God has the power to fulfill His promises	He never promises something that He lacks the ability to accomplish.	Romans 4:20–21 — Abraham was “fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.”
God’s Word always accomplishes His purpose	His declarations are not empty words; they produce the result He intends.	Isaiah 55:11 — “It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please.”
God has a proven record of faithfulness	Scripture repeatedly records God fulfilling every promise He made.	Joshua 21:45 — “Not a word failed of any good thing which the LORD had spoken...All came to pass.”
God demonstrated His commitment through Jesus’s Sacrifice for us	God has proven His love and promises are not merely words.	Romans 8:32 — “He who did not spare His own Son...how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?”
God secures His promises in Christ	Jesus is God’s decisive confirmation that His promises will be fulfilled.	2 Corinthians 1:20 — “For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen.”

Barrier	How It Shows Up	Truth to Correct	Action to Take
Jesus is not fully Lord	I reserve control over certain parts of my life.	Everything belongs under Christ's lordship (Luke 6:46) .	Identify and surrender one area still under your control.
Self-centered purpose	Most of my resources serve my comfort and advancement.	I was redeemed to live for Christ—not for myself (2 Corinthians 5:15) .	Redirect a portion of your time or resources toward God's purposes.
God is not first	Kingdom investment receives my leftovers, if there are any.	I must seek God's kingdom, and do it first (Matthew 6:33) .	Schedule prayer, service, and giving before filling calendar and budget.
Earthly oriented perspective	I prioritize investments that promise immediate, visible returns.	Eternal fruit is more valuable than temporary gain (Matthew 6:19–21) .	Make one investment that may never repay you in this life.
Wrong view of ownership	I ask how much I must give rather than how God wants everything used.	Everything comes from God; I am its steward (1 Chronicles 29:14) .	Review your time, abilities, money, and influence with God.
Unbelief and Fear of lack	I withhold because I fear what sacrifice might cost me.	God sees, supplies, and rewards faithful obedience (Hebrews 11:6) .	Obey God in one area where fear has caused you to hold back.
Failure to abide in Christ	I serve from striving, guilt, obligation, or depend on personal strength.	Lasting fruit flows from receiving and remaining in Christ's love (John 15:5, 9) .	Spend time receiving from God before trying to serve for God.
Uncrucified flesh	Comfort, pride, fear, pleasure, or approval governs my choices.	Following Jesus requires denying self and crucifying the flesh (Luke 9:23; Gal 5:24) .	Name and surrender the competing desire limiting your obedience.
Unrecognized kingdom purpose	I wait for someone else to address the needs and opportunities around me.	God created and equipped me for good works (Ephesians 2:10) .	Identify one need you are equipped to help meet this week.
Self-reliance	I strive until exhausted or avoid acting because I feel inadequate.	My sufficiency and power to serve come from God (2 Corinthians 3:5) .	Ask Holy Spirit for direction and empowerment, take step in faith.

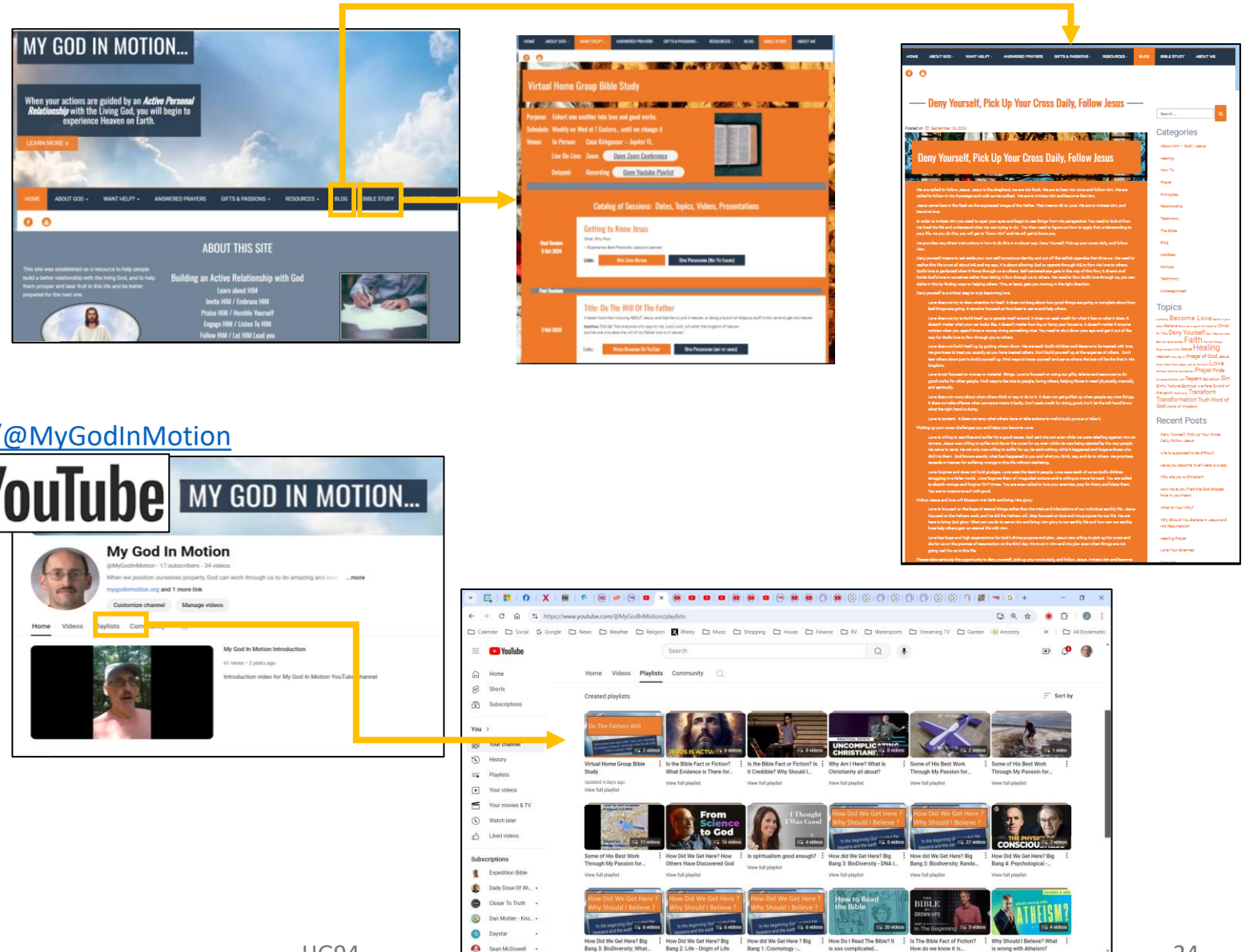
