Jesus Questioned The Disciples

Matthew 16:13-19

When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, “**Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?**”

So they said, “Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.”

He said to them, “**But who do you say that I am?**”

Simon Peter answered and said, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

Jesus answered and said to him, “Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

What Does He Mean By The “Son Of Man”

Daniel 7:9-10

His throne was a fiery flame, Its wheels a burning fire;
A fiery stream issued And came forth from before Him.

Confess Him as Lord	Openly recognize His authority and surrender your life to His rule.	Romans 10:9 — “Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead.”

Call to Action:

Be Bold: Answer Jesus' Question With Your Life

Examine whether your beliefs, priorities, and actions demonstrate that He is truly Lord.
- Set aside uninterrupted time with Jesus.
- Ask Him to reveal any unbelief or area of self-rule.
- Repent and surrender what He identifies.
- Receive what His finished work has made available.
- Take one specific action that demonstrates your trust and obedience.

Journaling Questions:

Lord, who do I truly believe You are, and how does my life agree or disagree with that belief?

Lord, what unbelief, misunderstanding, or resistance is keeping me from fully trusting You?

Lord, what area of my life have I not fully surrendered to Your lordship?

Lord, what have You already made available that I have not yet recognized or received?

Lord, what specific action are You asking me to take to demonstrate I trust and follow You?

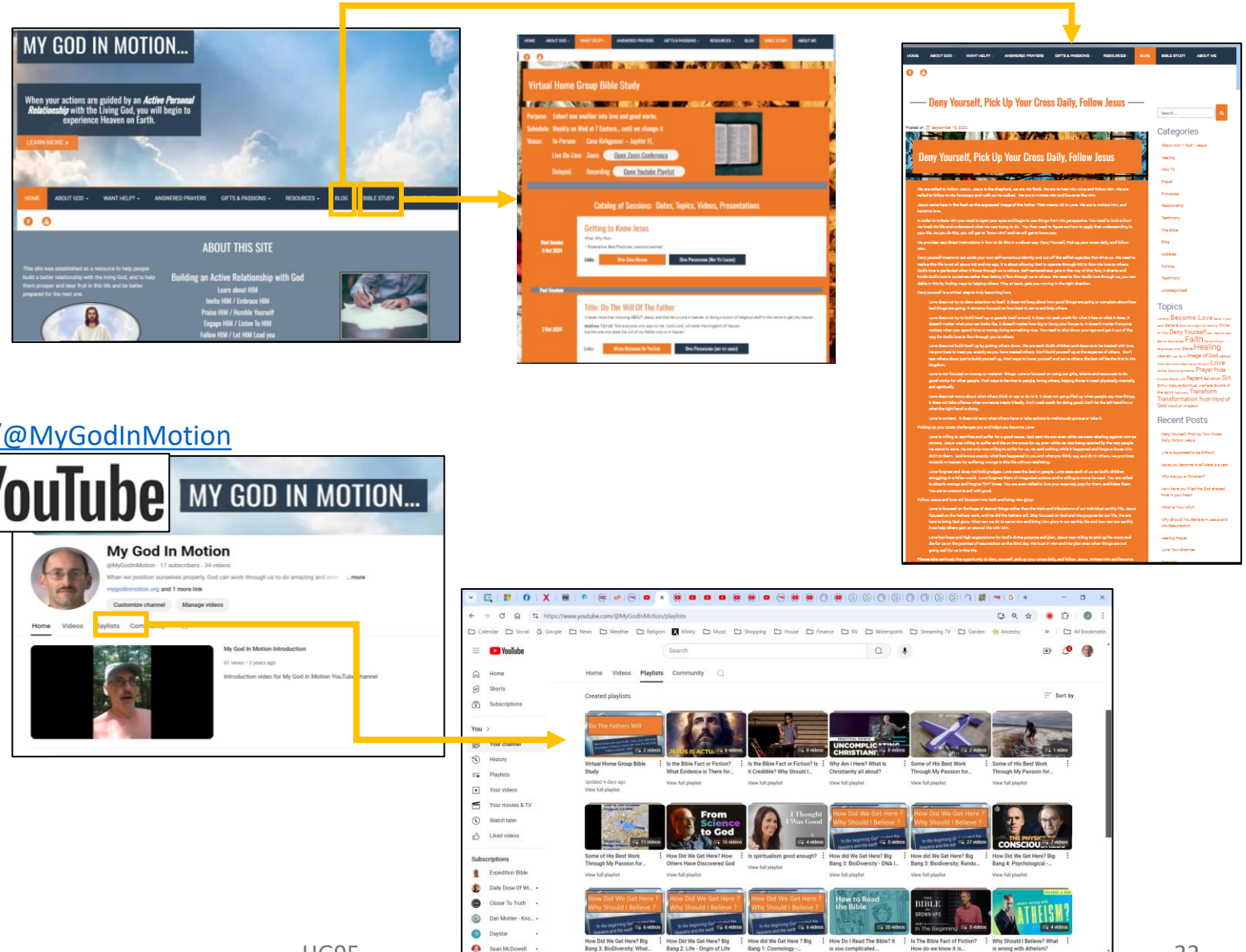
