

## God Foreshadows Christ Many Ways In The Old Testament

Mode of Revelation	Description	Examples
<b>Personal Appearance (Theophany / Christophany)</b>	God appears in visible or personal form, often speaking as the LORD	The Angel of the LORD (Genesis 16; Exodus 3), the Man who wrestled Jacob (Genesis 32), the Commander of the LORD's Army (Joshua 5)
<b>Messianic Titles</b>	Descriptive names that reveal identity and role	Son of Man (Daniel 7), Branch (Isaiah 11; Jeremiah 23), Shepherd (Psalm 23; Ezekiel 34)
<b>Foreshadowing Characters</b>	Real people whose lives pattern Christ's mission	Adam, Joseph, Moses, David, Boaz
<b>Redemptive Objects</b>	Physical items that symbolize Christ's work	Passover Lamb, Bronze Serpent, Ark, Manna, Veil
<b>Saving Events</b>	Historical acts that prefigure salvation	Exodus, Day of Atonement, Crossing the Red Sea, Jonah's deliverance
<b>Institutions</b>	God-ordained systems fulfilled in Christ	Priesthood, Sacrificial System, Temple, Sabbath, Jubilee

Angel of the LORD	Angel of the LORD to Hagar	Speaks as God, promises descendants, declares "I have seen Him who sees me"	Gen 16:7-13	Christ sees the afflicted, meets people personally, and gives hope before salvation history is complete
	Angel of the LORD to Abraham	Swears by Himself, stops the sacrifice of Isaac, reaffirms covenant	Gen 22:11-18	Christ is both the One who provides the sacrifice and the One who receives obedience
	Angel of the LORD in the Burning Bush	Appears in fire, speaks as "I AM," reveals God's name	Exodus 3:2-6	Christ is the eternal "I AM," present before incarnation, initiating redemption
	Angel of the LORD leading Israel	Goes before Israel, carries God's name, forgives sins	Exodus 23:20-23	Christ leads, protects, and carries divine authority
	Angel of the LORD to Gideon	Accepts sacrifice, speaks as the LORD, brings peace	Judges 6:11-24	Christ commissions the weak and empowers deliverance
	Angel of the LORD to Manoah	Ascends in flame, identified as "Wonderful," accepts worship	Judges 13:3-22	Christ is the Wonderful Deliverer, worthy of worship
	Angel of the LORD to Zechariah	Intercedes for Jerusalem	Zechariah 1:12-13	Christ intercedes on behalf of God's people
Divine Figure	Son of Man before the Ancient of Days	Comes on clouds, receives dominion, worship, and an eternal kingdom	Dan 7:13-14	Christ is the eternal King whose authority is granted by the Father
	LORD appearing to Samuel	LORD stands and calls Samuel by name	1 Sam 3:10	Christ calls individuals into service personally
	LORD speaking in the Psalms	Speaks as the divine King and Son	Psalms 2; Psalm 110	Christ reigns as God's Son and eternal Priest-King
Commander / Warrior	Commander of the LORD's Army	Appears as a man, accepts worship, commands holiness	Joshua 5:13-15	Christ is the divine Warrior who fights for God's people
	LORD as Mighty Warrior	Appears clothed in splendor, brings salvation	Isaiah 63:1-6	Christ executes righteous judgment and redemption
Glory Presence	Glory entering the Temple	Glory enters and fills the temple	Ezekiel 43:1-7	Christ is God dwelling among His people
Human Form	Man who wrestles Jacob	Wrestles physically, blesses Jacob, Jacob declares he saw God face to face	Genesis 32:24-30	Christ engages us personally, transforms identity through surrender
	Fourth Man in the Fiery Furnace	Appears "like the Son of God," protects from fire	Dan 3:24-25	Christ is present with His people in suffering and preserves them
	LORD as Shepherd	Personally shepherds, rescues, and feeds His flock	Ezekiel 34:11-16	Christ is the Good Shepherd who seeks and saves
Pierced One	LORD who is pierced	God speaks of being pierced and mourned	Zechariah 12:10	Christ bears wounds that bring repentance and cleansing
